	Mobile phone mast. A meeting had been held with Rory Stewart MP. Steve Pattinson and the Clerk were present. Mr Stewart said there would be no money for a mobile phone mast alone but there was a possibility of funding for a 4G mast which would enable broadband as well as a mobile signal and he would look into it. Cllr Tarbitt said there was to be a second phase involving satellite dishes and she would keep us informed.

This account would be kept for unforeseen expenditure and any surplus on the Current Account at the end of the next financial year could be added.
